Pierre Joffrion et de Marie Briau habitans de cette

Ledit Louïs Roulleau a declaré ne Scavoir Signer



**English translation :**

The seventh of April of the year One thousand six hundred and ninety-eight, the publication of the three announcement having been made, and having found no impediment, The marriage was done and Solannised between Jaques Eriché said Louveteau , thirty four years old, son of Jaques Eriché and Catherine Pin from the parish of Louveteau Archbishop of Roüen of a part, and Marie Joffrion widowed of Pierre La Varrenne said L'Espérance, twenty-five year old, daughter of Pierre Joffrion and Marie Briau inhabitants of this Parish. The said marriage was celebrated in the presence of Mr. René Culleriers, and Mr. Pierre L'Amoureux, and Louïs Roulleau, friend of said spouse, and Francois L'Amoureux, and Pierre L'Estage and Susanne Charbonnier, friend of said wife.

Said Louïs Roulleau said he did not know how to sign.

**Remarks:**

**The presences at the wedding:**

- a) Pierre Lamoureux said St-Germain is a rich merchant of Montreal.
  - b) François Lamoureux is the son from the previous one (Pierre Lamoureux).
  - c) Susanne Charbonnier is the daughter of the second wife of the same Pierre Lamoureux.
  - d) René Culleriers is Susanne Charbonnier's uncle.
  - e) Pierre de Lestage is another Montreal merchant.
  - f) Louis Roulleau who does not sign is Françoise's husband Joffrion, the bride's sister, Marie Joffrion.
- So we can think that at that time Jacques had close ties with the merchants of Ville Marie and especially with Pierre Lamoureux. Did he come to Montreal to work for them? Did he know them before? We do not know.
